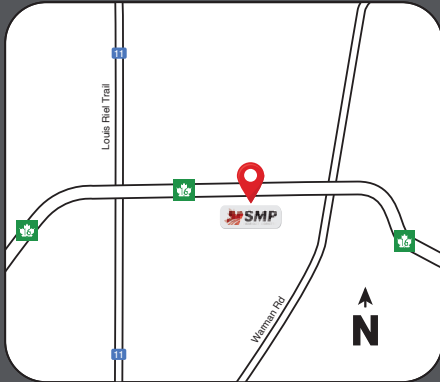

Additionally, GM offers uniquely engineered OEM solutions for front- and rear-end collisions that can be installed using predetermined fix locations, such as die marks or factory seams.

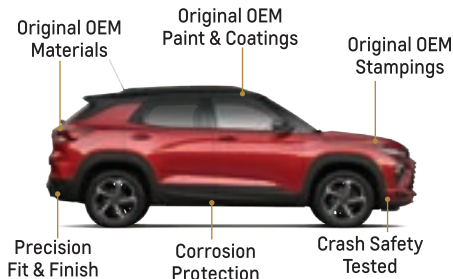

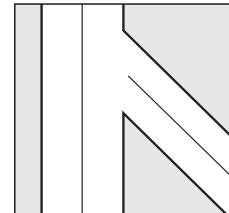
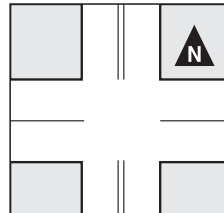

Police

Saskatchewan motorists will only have to report motor vehicle collisions to police if the collision involves:

- > Any bodily injury or death
- > A hit-and-run
- > A driver impaired by alcohol or drugs
- > A motor vehicle towed from the scene
- > An out-of-province vehicle

Normally, police would be dispatched to the collisions described above. One exception may be an owner's discovery that his/her vehicle has been damaged in a hit-and-run, but the vehicle can still be safely driven to your local police or RCMP detachment. In such a case, the owner could make a report in person at Police Headquarters.

You do NOT have to report to the police if only property damage was sustained, no matter the value of the damage.

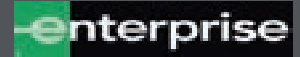
